COST INCREASE EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2019

- ❖ Test fees must be paid to ETS online or over the phone and test center fees must be paid to HRDC on or before the testing day. **Please have exact fee amount for HRDC as we are unable to make change.** If another agency is paying for your test, you must bring confirmation with you (a letter from the paying party). Fees are as follows:

Tests	Fee to ETS	Fee to HRDC
Full Battery (5 tests)	\$75	\$15
Single sub test	\$15	\$3

- ❖ Test fees are good for 1 year from date of purchase. If testing is not completed in this amount of time, new fees will be assessed.
- ❖ **Failure to arrive within 10 minutes of scheduled testing time will result in rescheduling. Additional fees may be imposed.**
- ❖ A **photo ID is required** on the day of testing. ID must contain the name as it appears on the registration, birthdate, and signature. If you have an out-of-state ID, you must bring in proof of residence such as mail in your name delivered to your Montana address.
- ❖ **Cell phones or other electronic devices, food or drink, testing aids, and personal calculators are not allowed in the testing room.**
- ❖ Clients who are **17 or 18** years of age must have an original school document from their former school clearly identifying the candidate by name, date of birth, and last school enrollment date; granting approval for the student to take the test and signed by chief education officer submitted to HRDC **at least 72 hours prior to testing** for Chief Examiner approval.
- ❖ Clients who are 16 years of age must contact Chief Examiner to discuss eligibility process to test.
- ❖ **Former GED test scores are no longer valid.**

Failure to adhere to any of these rules may result in dismissal from the test, forfeiture of fees, and cancellation of scores.
