



### Q2 Do you live in Fort Belknap?



### Q3 Do you live in Rocky Boy?



# Q4 Which of the following do you feel are the biggest challenges to your community as a whole?(check 3)















### Q10 Do you have reliable transportation?



### Q11 What are your barriers to reliable transportation? (check all that apply)




### Q12 Were you able to access dental care in the last year?

# Q13 If no, why did you not receive dental care in the last year? (check all that apply)



### Q14 What best describes your present housing?




### Q15 Are your housing conditions adequate?







### Q19 Do you have a need for childcare?



# Q20 If yes, what are your barriers to childcare services? (check all that apply)








### Q21 Do you have reliable phone access?



### Q23 Where do you usually use the Internet?








## Q26 What are your barriers to health care? (check all that apply)







## Q27 Have you had your power turned off in the last year?






## Q29 Have you been able to meet food needs in the last year?

# Q30 If no, what are your barriers to meeting food needs? (check all that apply)







# Q31 What is your annual household income?



# Q32 What is your age?



## Q33 What is your gender? (check all that apply)





## Q34 What is your ethnicity/race?(check all that apply)




